This standard is used to assess leather manufacturers on the following aspects: Water &amp; Energy Usage, Solid Waste &amp; Effluent Management, Air &amp; Noise Emissions, Traceability, Health &amp; Safety, Chemical Management, Restricted Substances, and Compliance &amp; Chromium VI (CrVI) Management.</p>
	<p>REACH is a regulation of the European Union (EU), adopted to improve the protection of human health and the environment from risks that can be posed by chemicals. To comply with the regulation, European companies must identify and manage the risks linked to the substances they manufacture and market in the EU. Leather manufactured in Europe is Reach compliant.</p>

	<p>The UL GREENGUARD Gold Certification Standard includes health-based criteria for chemicals and also requires lower total VOC emissions levels to ensure that products are acceptable for indoor environments. Volatile Organic Compounds (VOCs) are carbon-based chemicals (such as formaldehyde) that easily become vapors or gases. Representative samples of certified products have undergone rigorous scientific testing to meet stringent chemical emissions requirements. UL GREENGUARD Gold Certified® products limit emissions of more than 360 VOCs and total chemical emissions.</p> <p><b>All our semi-aniline and pure aniline collections achieved GREENGUARD GOLD Indoor Air Quality certification.</b></p>
	<p>MSAP (MindClick Sustainability Assessment Program) rates social and environmental impacts throughout the product lifecycle.
